



**Победительница конкурса 2016 года

Цього року в нашій школі вперше проводився

літературно-лінгвістичний конкурс ім. В. Л. Скалкіна «Кращий знавець англійської мови» для учнів 8-11 класів.

Видатний вчений і талановитий педагог, В.Л. Скалкін зіграв велику роль в історії нашої школи і нашого міста. Після закінчення нашої школи, навчався в Москві, а потім знову повернувся до рідного інтернату як викладач. Протягом довгих років працював на посаді завідувача кафедри англійської мови в Одеському державному університеті ім. І. І. Мечникова, займався науковою діяльністю. Ним було створено більше 150 наукових робіт і декілька підручників. Тому участь в цьому конкурсі – велика честь для наших учнів.

Ініціатором цього конкурсу стала донька Володимира Львовича та Євген Олександрович Поздняков. Декілька місяців з'ясували Положення про конкурс, розробляли завдання, визначали членів журі, обговорювали нагороду переможцю. Було визначено, що конкурс буде проводитися в три етапи.

На першому етапі конкурсу учні виконали індивідуальні лексико-граматичні завдання, що відповідають даній віковій категорії. Журі у складі вчителів школи-інтернату визначили переможців першого етапу, які отримали право перейти до другого етапу конкурсу. В першому етапі конкурсу прийняли участь **41 учень школи**.

На другий етап конкурсу перейшов **тільки 21 учень**.

Під час другого етапу журі у складі викладачів факультету романо-германської філології ОНУ ім. І. І. Мечникова перевірило навички аудіювання і усного мовлення. **Тільки 5 учнів вийшли** в фінал конкурсу - **третій етап конкурсу**, який проводився у формі письмового твору на задану тему.

Творчі роботи п'яти фіналістів було відправлено журі у складі випускників Одеської школи-інтернату №2, які професійно володіють англійською мовою.

І ось, нарешті, 13 травня прийшов такий лист:
